Description

Larvae enjoy tight spaces similar to those found in the rotting wood where they live the wild.

Substrate added to a growing jar needs to be compressed gently to allow the correct density and this product allow substrate to be easily added and then compressed.

Use:

- Step 1: add substrate to a level about 80% of the growing jar using the spoon end.
- Step 2: compress the substrate with the tamper end to about 1/2 its original depth
- Step 3: add more substrate to within a few mm of the top of the jar
- Step 4: place larvae on the surface and replace and tighten lid.

The larva will burrow down through the compressed substrate and create the correct density.
